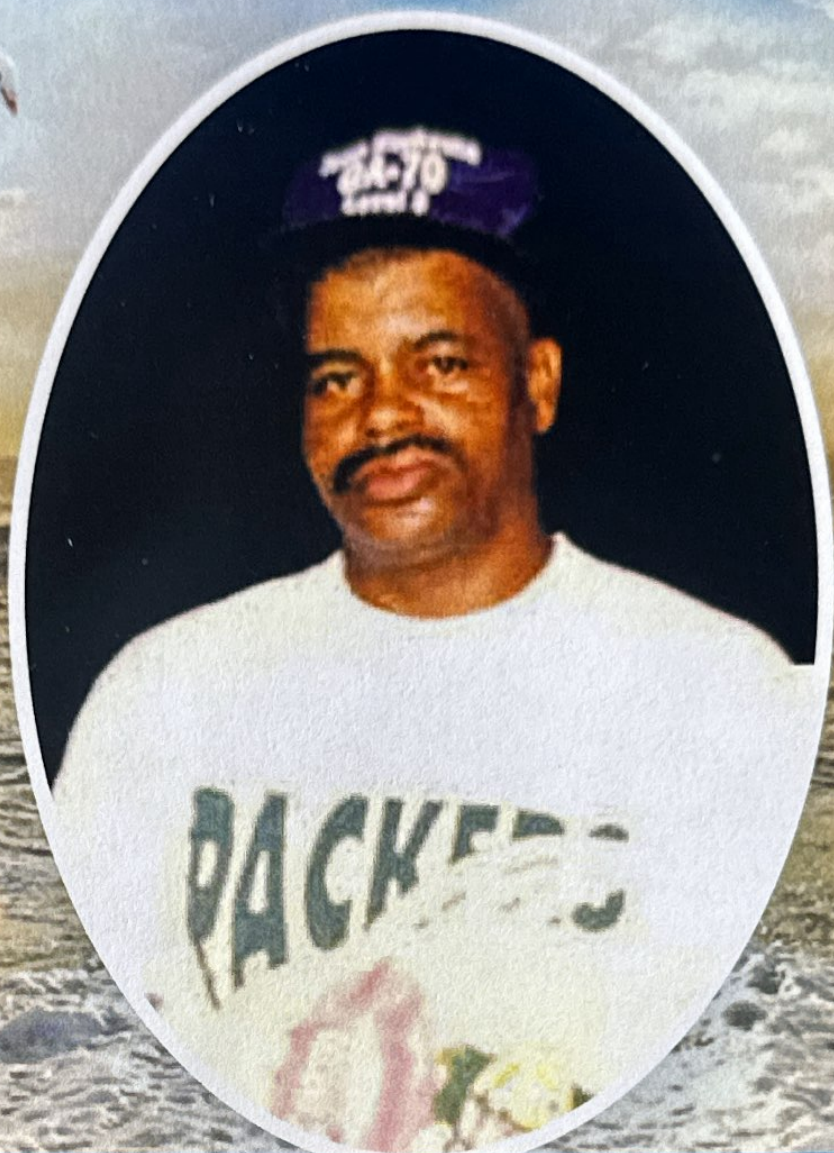

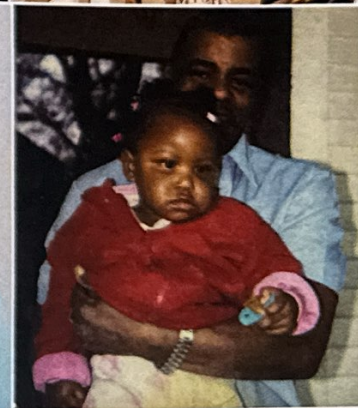
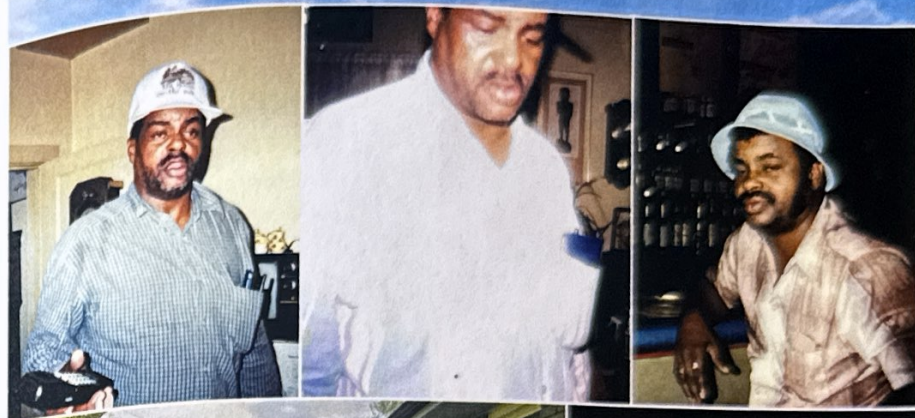
Obituary

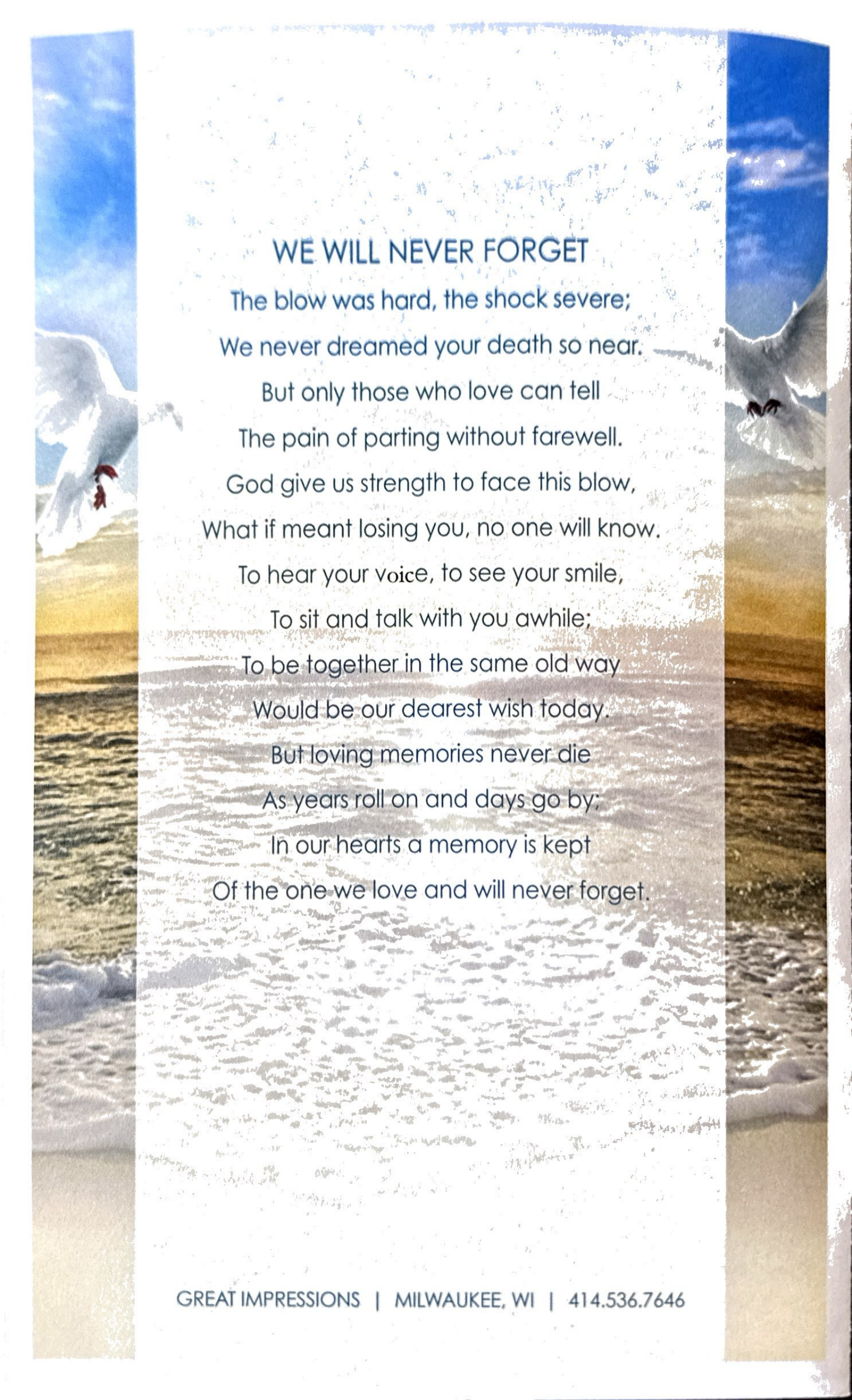
Arthur Lee Davis was born on February 21, 1952 to the late James and Anna Lou Davis. He was one of nine children.
